Mansion House Members:

We are excited to be able to open the pool under less strict State and County rules and regulations than last year. However, there are still some COVID protocols that the State of Virginia and the County of Fairfax will require we adhere to if we are to remain open during the summer. They are as follows:

- Outdoor and indoor swimming pools may be open, provided occupancy is limited to no more than 75 percent of the lowest occupancy load on the certificate of occupancy, which is 262 for Mansion House. We will not use a reservation system. Instead, if we reach the 75% capacity, we will not allow more members in until others leave.
- All swimmers maintain at least **ten feet of physical distance** from others who are not family members. We will rely on the lifeguards to monitor this and request member assistance in adhering to this regulation.
- Seating may be provided with at least **six feet** of spacing between persons who are not members of the same family. Because of the spacing requirements, seating may be limited.
- Masks must be worn while in the club house.
- Mansion House is required to screen members for COVID-19 symptoms, a positive diagnostic test for the virus that causes COVID-19 in the prior ten days or known exposure to a COVID-19 case in the 14 days prior to admission to the venue/facility. Members will be asked if they have or are:
 - Currently experiencing fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher) or a sense of having a fever.
 - A new cough that cannot be attributed to another health condition.
 - New shortness of breath that cannot be attributed to another health condition.
 - New chills that cannot be attributed to another health condition.
 - New sore throat that cannot be attributed to another health condition.
 - New muscle aches that cannot be attributed to another health condition or specific activity (such as physical exercise).

We do hope that as the summer progresses, these guidelines become even less restrictive. Mansion House will continue to monitor the guidance and regulations required by the County and the State, making necessary changes as we go.
